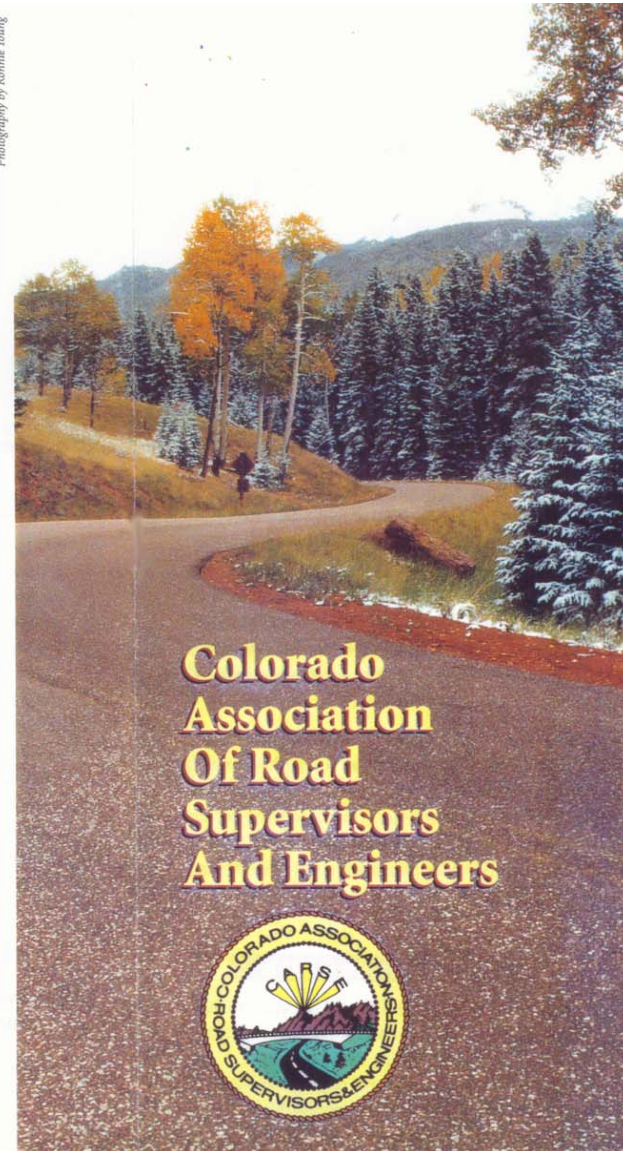
What is CARSE?

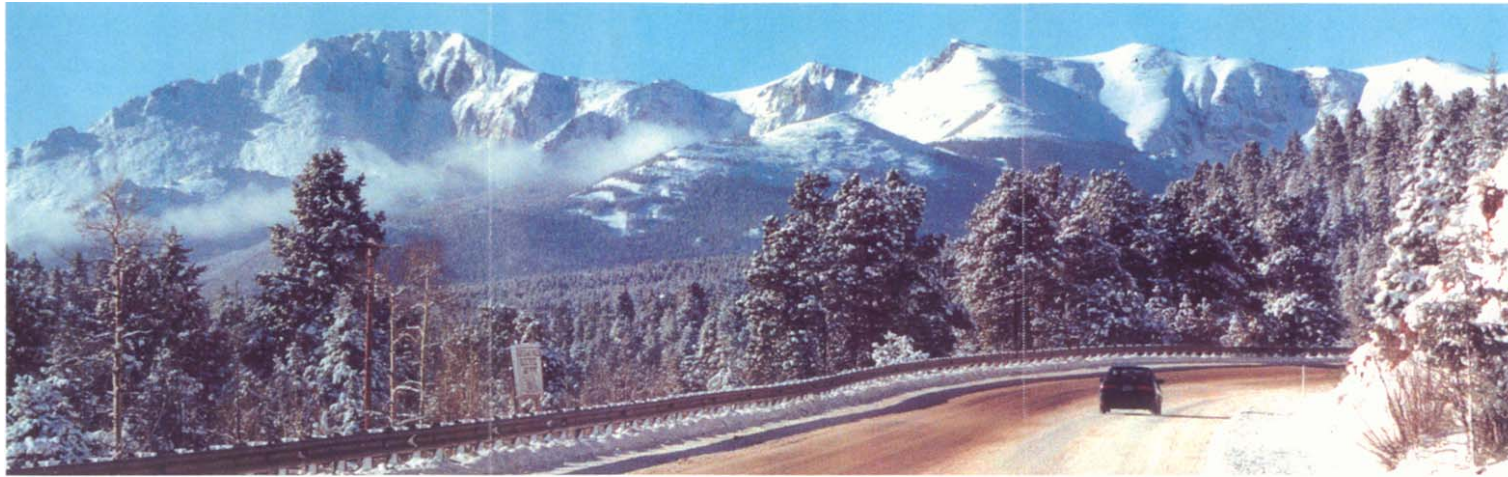

Who can belong to CARSE?

County Engineers, Directors of Public Works, Directors of Transportation, County Road Supervisors, Assistant County Engineers, Assistant County Road Supervisors, Foreman or any other staff personnel who are regularly employed on a full-time basis by any one of the counties of the state of Colorado. You do not need to have a professional engineer's license to be a member of CARSE.

In addition, CARSE provides for sustaining memberships for those not employed by counties but who have a sincere interest in the affairs of the Association. Sustaining members can participate in all activities of the organization, but may not vote or hold office. Along with membership comes access to CARSE mailing list and notice of all CARSE meetings and activities.

Affiliation with CARSE

CARSE is an affiliate of the National Association of County Engineers (NACE), the only national organization dedicated to advancing the engineering, management and professional standards of county public works officials. CARSE membership provides for membership in NACE at a reduced membership fee.

When Does CARSE MEET?

CARSE usually holds two conferences each year in conjunction with Colorado Counties, Inc. The Summer Conference is usually held in mid-June in a mountain resort area. The Winter Conference is usually held in late November or early December in a Front Range location, at which time the annual meeting takes place. These conferences unusually include two and one half days of programs consisting of technical sessions, managerial/leadership workshops and guest speakers. These workshops have proven to be beneficial in providing counties with proposed legislation that impacts counties and brings counties up to date on new regulation. These workshops are also beneficial to see how other counties are handling the impacts that all counties are facing today with growth.
